

FVBC Protocol for Teams/Spectators (Updated 12/30/20):

1. Players and Coaches will enter together and be temperature checked by the Site Director before allowing spectators to enter the venues. Our goal is to begin allowing teams to enter starting at 7:00am – just be patient while my staff sets-up before opening the doors.

2. Officiating Duties:

- *Head or Assistant coach is the R2 for the match
- *Only the scorer and flipper at the scores table (**with mask on**)
- *No Line Judges
- *No eating at the scores table
- ***Bring own pencils and pens for scorekeeping**
- *No LIBERO tracking or LINE-UP Sheets exchanged

3. Players need to bring their own water bottles – DO NOT SHARE!!!!

4. Players not working the match – **please sit in designated area or exit gym area** whenever possible to prevent excess crowds around the courts.

***Spend time outside of the venues if weather allows:**

Indian Rocks – hallway or lobby

First Lutheran – designated area or outside

Delphi Academy – lobby near restrooms

Highland Rec. – outside near pool/concession area

Wiregrass Complex – outside the facility or in cars

Bishop McLaughlin – outside or in massive lobby adjacent to gym

Trinity VBC Center – outside the gym in the shaded areas

Clearwater Gyms – outside in designated areas or on pool deck

5. **Spectators for the 2021 New Year's Classic:**

*per guidelines suggested by the Region and the local authorities, each player is allowed a MAX of 3 spectators. This will help with keeping the numbers down and allow for the best possibility of social distancing during the event. If anything changes, we will notify all Club Directors immediately.

*All spectators must be temperature checked BEFORE purchasing admission and masks must be always worn while inside the buildings

***Penalty points can be given to your team for not adhering to the NEW Florida Region's mask policy.**
